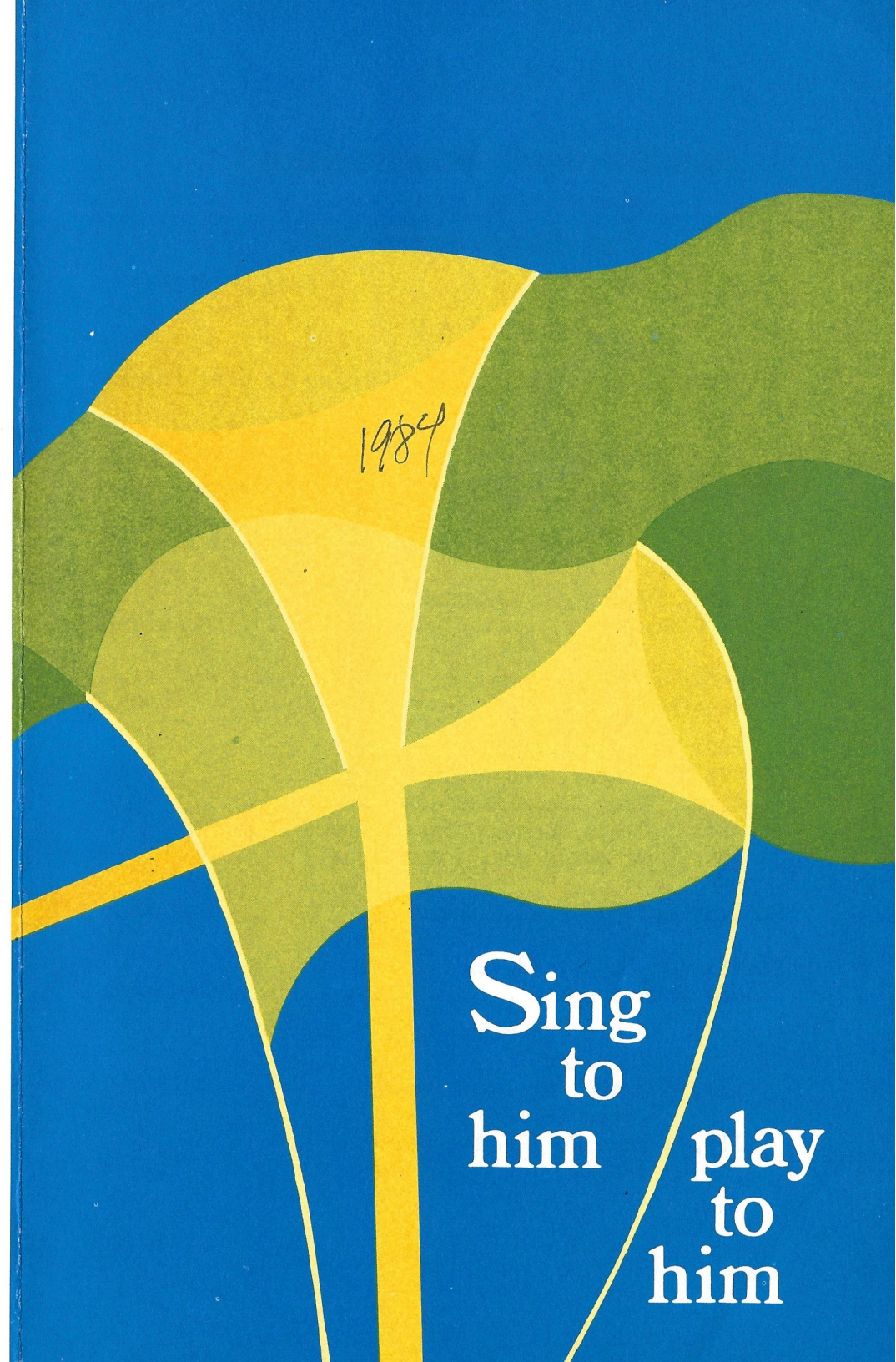

He holds degrees from Tulane University, North Texas State, and the Universities of Toronto and California (Berkeley). He has performed throughout the South, as well as in the San Francisco Bay area, New England, and in Europe.
